

USSA Percentage Program

PURPOSE: Enables members of USSA to identify and maintain records on their non-purebred replacement seed stock and wethers.

RULES AND REGULATIONS*

1. In order to record an animal in the USSA Percentage Registration Program, you must be a member in good standing of USSA or UJSSA.
2. At least one parent must be registered in the USSA Purebred Registry or the USSA Percentage Registry.
3. Percentage animals must be identified by permanent positive identification.
4. Animals registered in the USSA Percentage Registry will receive a Percentage Certificate of Registration (printed on green paper).
5. An animal with a percentage registration number will not be permitted to enter the purebred flock book nor will any of its progeny until the 15/16 level of purity is reached. Once progeny reaches a level of purity, the registration will be printed on a Certificate of Registration (printed on white paper).

**It is helpful if members submit percentage registrations on the Application for Percentage Registration (provided in the directory, on the website or from the office). If you would like to submit an application to register percentage sheep and do not have the correct application, please indicate on the application that the animals being registered are percentage Suffolks.*
